LEADER TERRITORIES IN 2014–2020

- Rural area villages, small towns and towns up to 6000 inhabitants (excluding centers of municipalities).
- LAG area population not less than 6 000 and not more than 150 000 inhabitants.
- Rural area takes 97 % of the territory of LT.
- Rural area has 31 % of LT inhabitants.









49 LAGs selected, incl. 3 bi-sectoral (99% rural territory)



















































































FINANCIAL PERSPECTIVE OF LITHUANIA IN RURAL AREAS IN

LAGs' COOPERATION PROJECTS (1)



Main requirements:		
1. Beneficiaries:Rural LAG;Bi-sectoral LAG.	 2. Eligible partners: Rural LAGs; Urban LAGs; FLAGs; Bi-sectoral LAGs; partners corresp. requir. of Reg. No 1305/2013 Article 44 par. 2 part a 	
3. Scope of cooperation:territorial;transnational.	 4. Eligibility conditions: cooperation agreement; min. 2 partners, aiming at implementation partners LDSs' objectives via cooperation; joint activity (not simple exchange of experiences); project coordinator. 	





LAGs' COOPERATION PROJECTS (2)

Main requirements:

5. <u>Ineligible</u> expenditure:

real estate acquisition expenses.

6. Support rate, aid intensity:

- > preparatory technical support: **3 000 EUR**, up to **80 %** of total eligible expenditure;
- > up to 100 000 Eur per project, up to 80 %;
- advanced payment may be applied.

7. Eligible expenditure:

<u>Preparatory support (TNC only):</u> travel and/or transport rental; accommodation; health insurance and secondment; communication & postal costs; translation/interpretation.

<u>Project's:</u> project coordination; expenses in line with requirements defined in the Reg. No 1303/2013 Articles 65–71 and Reg. No 1305/2013 Articles 45, 60–63; common organizational structure establishment and activities; in-kind contribution (works, goods, services, land or other real estate).





SELECTION CRITERIA

- 5 and more;	
- 4 partners;	Up to 30
- 3 partners.	
2. Variety of partners:	Up to 20
- rural+urban + bi-sectoral LAGs;	
- rural+urban + fisheries LAGs;	
- 2 types of LAGs.	
3. The main objective of the cooperation project – to seek EU's rural	Up to 30
development priority:	
- 6A; 3A;	
- 6B; 5B;	
- 4A.	
4. Target group of the project:	Up to 20
- socially vulnerable groups (the elderly, disabled, facing poverty,	
unemployed, large families);	
- young people.	






LT LAGs' Cooperation Experience:

PARTNER COUNTRIES IN TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION PROJECTS 2007–2013




